ORDERED		ROUTINE PREWRITTEN ORDERS – LABOR AND DELIVERY	TIME
Date	Time		ORDER NOTED
		1. Admit L&D, Dr. Holzhauer	
		2. DX: Term pregnancy in labor	
		3. Condition stable	
		4. NPO – Ice chips	
		5. Routine L&D vital signs, call for diastolic BP equal to or greater than 90, systolic BP equal to or greater than 140. (BP not valid during contractions)	
		6. IV LR 500 ml bolus, then 125 ml/hr of D5LR	
		7. Continuous fetal monitoring	
		8. Once orders No. 5 through No. 8 are done, if there is no abnormal bleeding & fetal tracing is normal, nurse may examine patient and call results to MD	
		9. If declines epidural and fetal tracing is normal:	
		Nalbuphine 10 mg IVP every 2 hours as needed for contractions and/or mild pain	
		Nalbuphine 20 mg IVP every 2 hours as needed for contractions and/or moderate to severe pain	
		- OR -	
		Meperidine (Demerol) 25 mg IVP every 3 hours as needed for contractions and/or mild pain	
		Meperidine (Demerol) 50 mg IVP every 3 hours as needed for contractions and/or moderate to severe pain	
		- OR -	
		Butorphanol (Stadol) 1 mg IVP every 2 hours as needed for contractions and/or mild pain	
		Butorphanol (Stadol) 2 mg IVP every 2 hours as needed for contractions and/or moderate to severe pain	
		10. For any abnormalities of tracing or meconium stained fluid, place on left side and start O2 at 10 L/min by mask and call MD at once	
		11. Routine Cesarean permit on all patients, plus permit for post partum tubal if desires	
		12. Lab: RPR, Type and Screen, CBC with diff., and UA	
		13. Catheterize as needed if unable to void – cath. UA for heavy show or ruptured membranes	
		14. Promethazine (Phenergan) 25 mg IV or 50 mg IM every 3 hours as needed for nausea
